An abstract is a succinct summary of your research. It should be clear, well-organized and accurate. It should include *Background* (including the reason for the research), *Methods*, *Results* and *Conclusion*.

Please note the following requirements:

- Save abstract with your last name as the document name.
- Pay close attention to abstract format. Incorrectly formatted abstracts will be returned.
- See example below of correctly formatted abstract (2nd page).

Abstract Format

Title (Bold)

Student Name with Faculty Mentor's name

Department

Institution (probably either UW or community college)

Type of Presentation (Oral, poster, or both)

Supporting Program
(Honors, EPSCoR, etc.)

Hometown, State

Text of Abstract limited to 200 words. Full justification, use 12 Point Times New Roman font, 1 inch margins, and single spacing.
